The appointment of a third new member of the Montana State University Dept. of Foreign Languages has been announced by Dr. Gordon B. Castle, acting president of MSU. He is Dr. Robert W. Cannaday, Jr., who will be assistant professor of French. The appointments of Dr. Douglas C. Sheppard and Louis T. Jardine were announced previously.

Dr. Cannaday did postdoctoral work in Paris last year at the Sorbonne as a Fulbright Fellow and was visiting professor of Spanish at the University of Virginia this past summer. He took an A.B. in history at Roanoke College in 1946 and M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in French at the University of Virginia, where he was a member of Phi Beta Kappa and the Raven Society.

He served with the infantry and the combat engineers in the European Theater in World War II and with the Corps of Engineers in Korea in 1951-52. He is married to the former Nina Ougritchich de Trebinsky, a graduate of the College Ste.-Marie, Paris. They have one son.
