The Chairman opened the meeting by introducing Mr. Robert
Herrig, who read his prepared statement (Exhibit A). A question
and answer period followed.

Mr. Fred Barclay, Missoula County Assessor, testified before the Committee. He said that Missoula is unique in that he is also the director of land classification, and this has worked very well in Missoula. His main point is that people in these offices should be appointed after examinations for qualifications. Also, the pay is not adequate to get and keep qualified personnel. A question and answer period followed.

Mr. Zinnecker introduced the county commissioners present. He said they have one minor revision to the testimony they gave yesterday and explained same (Exhibit B). Mr. Pierce requested time for his testimony on Thursday or Friday. The Committee recessed at 11:45 a.m. to reconvene at 2 p.m.

At 2 p.m. Mrs. Eggert read a prepared statement (Exhibit D).

Most of the other witnesses present agreed with Mrs. Eggert's statement. Mrs. Brown distributed her prepared statement (Exhibit E). Both witnesses then answered questions from the Committee.

Mr. Schmidt suggested that instead of absentee ballots being delivered to the polls, it could be done better by delivering them to the court house to be counted under a special board under the direction of the county commissioners. Mrs. Blend and Mrs. Erdmann agreed to carry this suggestion as a delegate proposal. A long question and answer period followed.

Mr. Schraeder made a short statement about the problems there would be in combining city and county treasurers. He then

answered questions from the Committee.

Mr. Axtmann read his prepared statement (Exhibit F), and answered questions from the Committee.

There was some discussion about different committee schedules. Members of this Committee would like to attend other hearings.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
