Meeting was called by Pres't. Craig - The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Com. on Athletics made a partial report <sup>and asked</sup> for the faculty sanction to play a game of Basket Ball on the 25<sup>th</sup> inst. <sup>with Pullman</sup> - Moved to permit the same carried.

A request was presented verbally by Pres't Craig asking the sanction of the faculty for a Senior class ball to raise funds for a memorial.

M. 2d carried - That the faculty do not approve of this means of raising money for a memorial.

The matter of holding a debate with Pullman as arranged by some students was brought to the attention of the faculty.

It was moved that this debate be declared off. - <sup>and</sup> that the Secretary notify the proper authorities at Pullman and give reasons. - 2d. Carried.

The Com. on the Hawthorne Lit. Society made its report. - which was read. - <sup>and</sup> on motion adopted, - and the committee's recommendation regarding changes in the constitution.

The Supplemental report presented by the same Com. was read + on not adopted.

Petition was read signed by W. D. Rourke and F. Williams asking the faculty to remove the vote of censure. - Moved to deny the request. Carried.

The Bute list of Base Ball players representing the School of Mines and the University list of players were presented. <sup>and read</sup> - These were given to the Com. on Athl. - Moved that the names of Mr. F. Williams and Knowlton be stricken from the list of <sup>University</sup> players. - The list was then approved on motion.
