Delegate C. B. McNeil appeared before the Committee and explained Delegate Proposal 79 (Exhibit A). He then answered questions from the Committee.

Representative Henry S. Cox appeared before the Committee to testify regarding home rule. His statement is attached (Exhibit B).

Representative William R. Campbell appeared before the Committee to testify regarding a summary of a Local Government Survey (Exhibit C).

Representative Harold McGrath, Senators Goodheart and Keenan spoke on local government problems and desires. Senator McOmber thinks the people are satisfied with their local government for the most part.

Mrs. Blend gave a summary of the Committee's thinking up to this time; and stated that we need a solution that would retain the status quo and also provide for change for areas that want it.

Mr. Arness and Mr. Ask explained their proposals for the benefit of the witnesses. There was a general discussion regarding those two proposal.

Mayor Micone of Butte made a short statement to the effect that local government should be given the power to have done what needs to be done.

Chairman Rygg and Roger Barber of the Revenue and Finance Committee appeared before the Committee regarding Exhibit D. Their tentative decisions are shown on that exhibit.

The Committee discussed powers of local government again. Mr. Ask's amended proposal is attached (Exhibit E).
