Mr. Geoffrey Brazier, principal sponsor of Delegate Proposal 110, appeared before the Committee and explained the proposal. He clarified wording in the proposal by saying, "After the effective date of this provision no public official can succeed himself in office more than two successive terms." He then answered questions from the Committee.

The Chairman appointed Mr. Arness, Miss Sparks and Mrs. Payne to write the minority proposal.


Mr. Ask moved that Section 5 of yesterday's Exhibit B be adopted. Motion carried (issue 1).

Mrs. Payne moved that the Committee add a new section "The legislature shall have no power to set salaries of any officer or employee who is paid out of taxes levied by any government unit smaller than the state." After some discussion, the motion was voted on and failed (issue 2).
