STATEMENT OF SENATOR MIKE MANSFIELD (D. MONTANA)

Mr. President, prior to adjournment of the Thirty-sixth Legislature of the State of Montana it went on record in behalf of Federal Aid for classroom construction and improvement of teachers' salaries.

I am especially pleased with the action taken by the State Legislature because the two chief sponsors of this legislation in this Congress are my two distinguished colleagues, the senior Senator from Montana, James E. Murray, and the able Congressman of the First District, Lee Metcalf.

I have co-sponsored this legislation, as have a number of my colleagues here in the Senate, and I hope it will not be too long before we are able to consider this important legislation on the Floor of the Senate.

I ask unanimous consent that Senate Joint Resolution No. 4 be printed in the Congressional Record at the conclusion of my remarks.
