will be required. - of these 72 are compulsory
and 24 elective.

Moved that the part of the report which refers to the coach be adopted. - Carried. -

Petition was read from Mr. Earl Greenough asking to be allowed to drop Prep German. - On motion allowed. -

Mr. Walter H. Hay petitioned to be allowed to drop Physics. - Granted. -

Petition was presented by Prof. Tibbels for several students of the M. E. school asking to be allowed to organize an Association of Much. Enquiers. - On motion granted. -

Absences were reported against Mr. De Uers. - M. 2d that as long as absences of Mr. De Uers do not accumulate and his attendance is satisfactory no action be taken. - Ed.

M. to adopt a monthly University calendar of University events, to be prepared in advance. -

M. 2d carried that Prof. Conbar be appointed to prepare such a calendar. - Adjourned
