Discussed the matter of delinquencies among
the Athletes. - Suggested that Mr. Conibear work out

Mr. Quinones petitioned thru Prof. Aber for faculty
opinion regarding the scheduling of one or more

the Missoula Athl. Club. -

Tardiness of students was brought up and discussed. M. that 2 unexcused tardy ^{be considered} marks have the same effect as one unexcused absence. - This has same effect with the beginning of the 3d Semester. - Carried.

A petition was read from Mr. Heyfron asking (that) for his classification & grading, in order to graduate June '05. - It was referred to the Com. on grading & classification.

Petition signed by a number of students was presented by Prof. Sibley asking to be allowed to organize a local Greek Letter Fraternity ^(P. 2nd Min) leading to a chapt. of Delta U. Discussed - and on mot. granted.

Resolution was presented that no students be eligible except those having 32 credits or more. - Carried.

Petition was presented signed by several students asking to be allowed to form a Shakespeare Society. On motion referred to Profs. Corbin, Kellogg, & Allen. Carried.
