A petition was presented from Miss Sumner asking for re-instatement, which on mot. was granted.

A like action was taken regarding Miss Schilling.

A note was read from Mrs. Beck, mother of Mr. Walter Beck asking the faculty to allow the latter to drop History. On motion denied. The Secretary was asked to notify Mrs. Beck regarding the action and giving reasons for the denial.

Tardiness of students was brought up and discussed. M. that 2 unexcused tardy <sup>be considered</sup> marks have the same effect as one unexcused absence. - This has same effect with the beginning of the 3rd Semester. - Carried.

A petition was read from Mr. Keyfrow asking (that) for his classification & grading, in order to graduate June '65. - It was referred to the Com. on grading & classification.

Petition signed by a number of students was presented by Prof. Sibley asking to be allowed to organize a local Greek Letter Fraternity <sup>(P. 2nd Min)</sup> leading to a chapt. of Delta U. Discussed - and on mot. granted.

Resolution was presented that no students be eligible except those having 32 credits or more. - Carried.

Petition was presented signed by several students asking to be allowed to form a Shakespeare Society. On motion referred to Prof. Coburn, Kellogg, & Allen. Carried.

Adjourned February 21st.
