12 Whereas, ASUM Fiscal Policy Section 14, subsection 1, clause 1 states:

14 “14.1.1 At the beginning of each fiscal year, \$20,000 shall be deposited in the Special Allocation

17 Whereas, this title is confusing and is no longer what it is referred to as;

19 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Section 14, subsection 1, clause 1 of ASUM Fiscal Policy be
20 amended to read:
