10 Policy;

12 Whereas, ASUM Fiscal Policy Section 19, Subsection 6, Claus 1 states:

14 “19.6.1 College of Technology students will not be eligible for ASUM loans outside those
15 specifically designated for College of Technology students.”

17 Whereas, Missoula College students are equal to Mountain Campus students;

19 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Section 19, Subsection 6, Clause 1 of ASUM Fiscal Policy be
20 stricken;
