6:00 p.m.

The minutes of the April 1 meeting were approved as written.

President's Report

Senate ratified the following Senate appointments: Udo Fluck, Shaney Fossen, Bette Garlow and Jennifer Panasuk.

Keith Glaes answered questions about the proposed \$10 Campus Recreation fee (necessary because Campus Rec has been deleted from the Auxiliary Services area), relocation of the playing fields (Clover Bowl chosen for the new business building site) and the fencing of a River Bowl) playing area. The fee will be up for a referendum vote during elections this May.

Pat McCleary reported that the Campus Development Committee is
considering the fending of a playing area at the River Bowl.


