March 28<sup>th</sup>. 05. 4 P.M.

371 The faculty met in regular session. - The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. -

May 5<sup>th</sup> was taken by consent as the date for Senior Prom. -

A communication was read from the Secy of the Inter-state Oratorical Ass'n regarding the Oratorical to be held in Lawrence, Kansas. -

Moved to correspond with the facy <sup>further</sup> and that the matter be presented to the students at convocation of the 29<sup>th</sup> - to obtain their wish in the matter. - led.

Petition was read from several students asking for a change in rules regarding judges in the Buckley Oratorical.

Moved to refer this matter to the Committee on public performances - to report at the next meeting.

Moved that the President correspond with the Presidents of the Agricultural College & of the Wesleyan - disapproving the amendment passed at the Bozeman meeting, - i.e. the appointing of 5 judges for both thought & delivery. -

[Moved that before credit for work is given to any student coming from institutions not already accepted, the standing of these institutions be looked into by the Com. on Grading & Classification.] led.

The registration of Miss M. Welch was brought up. - asking that she be allowed to drop History of Painting. -

Write up of Departments for the Summer School was called for, to be handed into the Office at once. -

The list of contestants in Athletics was read, and delinquents were called for.

Moved that the Secretary inform Mr. McLeod the President of the Athl. Ass'n - that Mr. McLeod is not eligible to act as B. B. manager. - fact of delinquencies in work. -

Moved that announcement be made to the young women 3<sup>d</sup> hour of next Tuesday, that work will be dispensed with on the 4<sup>th</sup> hour to give the lady members of the faculty and the young women an opportunity to hear Miss Clarke of the Y. W. C. A. - led.

The registration of Miss Della Steward was reported unfinished. - It was moved that the Secretary notify Miss S. that she must immediately show evidence to do something or that a notification will be sent to her parents informing them of the facts. -

The matter of the registration of Mr. Allen Goble <sup>in F. H. drawing</sup> was referred to the chairman of the Prep. registration committee. -

M. that The president of the Athletic Association notify the faculty

Faculty met in reg. session at 4 P.M. - Minutes were read, corrected and approved.

- The [Comm. on Literary Performances] heard a report regarding the Buckley contest - and recommended that the same be postponed to April 19th. - also that two sets of judges be appointed - one for thought and comp. and one for delivery. - The report was <sup>ordered</sup> filed.

The committee proposed the following persons for judges on delivery. Messrs. Rynear, Evans, Parsons, Sawyer. Moved that the matter of the selection of judges be left to the performers and the Comm. on Public Performances. - C'd.

Pres. of the Athl. Association presented a list of students holding offices in the various lines of Athletics.

Pres. Craig made a verbal report concerning the grade of work in the Mont. College at Deer Lodge and the Deer Lodge High School. - (recommending that the Prof. of mathematics satisfy himself regarding credit brought by Miss Mary Welch in Trigonometry from the Mont. College.)

Petition was presented by the members of the Base Ball team requesting the faculty's permission to play with the Montana College. - On mot. denied.

Miss Stewart petitioned the fac. for re-instatement <sup>suspension was</sup> caused by unexcused absence. - On mot. the pet. was gr.

- The President reported <sup>a communication from the pres. of</sup> regarding the Interstate Oratorical Association stating that the contest had been postponed to Dec. '05. - and asking for the assurance that the U. of Mont. would send a delegate contestant. - Moved that the President send to the Secy a diplomatic answer. - Carried.

Moved that the Recital in the Department of Elocution be postponed to May 15<sup>th</sup>. - and that the Athletic function be given Apr. 28<sup>th</sup>. - Carried.
