Moved that in the Prep. M. E. course - German (15) be required in addition to the other work - C.

The following resolution, presented by Prof. Hartness was read:

Resolved: [That all morning lecture and recitation courses be changed so that the lectures or recitations shall be given for 3 hours on Mond. Wed. & Fri. two hours on Tues. & Thurs. - or five hours - Mond. Tues. Wed. Thurs. Fri.]

On vote the resol. was adopted.

Moved that the Pres't appoint the [Prog. com. for the next full schedule of studies.]

Pres't app'd. Prof. Elrod, Kiley, Wolf, Abr. Sibley, Hartness. Motion made at the last meeting regarding the granting of one degree in all courses was brought up &

motion that catalogue statement regarding degrees on page 68 be left unchanged. - Carried.

Moved that the Pres't appoint a Com. to make the required changes harmonizing the requirements of entrance with the work of Prep. Course. - Ref. to the Prog. com.

Prof. Howe asks for permission to add a course in Invertebrate Paleontology, also a <sup>Preparatory</sup> course in Mining Engineering. - Matter discussed.

Adjourned 7 o'clock - 7:15.

Minutes of previous two meetings were read and app'd. Petitions for <sup>(Base Ball game)</sup> with the school of Mines was presented. M. to refer the matter to the Com. on Athletics. & they to see that both teams conform to the rules of the Association. 2d. Carried. - (they to report the details etc. of the game to be played on June 13th.)

Pet. was presented from Mr. Chas. Farmer to be exp. from Gym. - Ref. to the Com. on Athl.

Pet. was read from Mr. Chas. Dyson - asking for re-instatement, suspension having been caused by 3 unexc. absences.

M. and seconded that action on this petition

be deferred to the next meeting and that Mr. Dyson be notified that he will be required to absent himself from the U. premises. - C.

Pet. from Miss Alice Welch was read asking to be allowed to drop History IV, caused by necessary absence of 3 weeks. - M. to gr. C.

Communication was read from Mr. Harman regarding the Northwest Grad. League & the reasons for joining the same. - M. to refer to Com on Student Affairs.

M. that the order of Quakey & the Declamatory Contests for the coming year be reversed. - C.

M. that the 3 debaters who represented the U. with Pullman be allowed a credit of 2 hours - C.

Program. Com. made a partial report. - Moved that the Com. be given power to act and be continued. - C.

Miss Kellogg asked to be allowed to add a 2 point course in sight reading. - Granted.

Miss Reiley asked to substitute a course in General Astronomy for Math IX. - Allowed.

Departments of Biol., Geology & Psychology asked to add a course in Organic Evolution. - 1 half year. (course of lectures) Gr.

Prof. Rowe read a scheme of [studies for the proposed course in Pre-Mining] M. that the course as presented be approved. C.

Prof. Starkins proposed a [course in Technical Chemistry] - moved that the course as offered be granted. C. - adjourned to meet Monday May 1st 4 P.M.
