Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) Childcare Oversight Committee is tasked with overseeing ASUM Childcare;

Whereas, The ASUM Childcare Oversight Committee helps the ASUM Childcare Director on issues related to ASUM Childcare and operations;

Whereas, ASUM has a duty to follow up with its investments;

Whereas, Article IV, Section 18, Subsection E of ASUM bylaws currently explains the duties and functions of ASUM Childcare Oversight Committee;

Whereas, Article IV, Section 18, Subsection E of ASUM bylaws currently reads:

“E. Duties and functions of the ASUM Childcare Oversight Committee will include:

1. Examining the budget of ASUM Childcare each spring prior to ASUM budgeting session.
2. Communicating issues within ASUM Childcare to the ASUM Senate when appropriate.
3. Working in conjunction with the ASUM Childcare director on issues related to ASUM Childcare and its operations.
4. General oversight of day-to-day business within ASUM Childcare where appropriate.”

Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Article IV, Section 18, Subsection E, Clause 5 of ASUM bylaws be added to read:

“5. Visiting all of the ASUM Childcare facilities at least once during each academic semester.”
