49 Life Committee set a realistic new deadline for breaking ground on new student housing
50 developments and inform ASUM of the new deadline when it is created;

53 work with leaders in the UM administration and the City of Missoula, as well as
54 interested community members and developers, to meet these ends by re-initiating
55 meetings of the Quality of Life advisory committee and actively working with private
56 developers to move new student housing projects forward;

58 Therefore, Let it Be Further Resolved, that ASUM requests an update from Mayor Engen
59 and UM President Royce Engstrom about recent developments pertaining to student-
60 oriented off-campus housing building projects by the conclusion of the 2014-2015
61 academic year;

63 Therefore, Let it Be Further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be Dr. Royce
64 Engstrom, UM President; John Engen, Mayor of Missoula; and Sandra Schoonover,
65 Director of the UM Residence Life Office.
