The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Report on Founders Day Committee was read and on mot. adopted.

The list of delinquent students was read.

M. that Mr. Cary be notified that he be required to drop 2 hours work fact. of delinquencies in two subjects.

Substitute moved to lay the matter on the table. 2d. Carried.

Moved that the seniors be notified of subjects in which delinquencies occur. 2d. Carried.
