From Mr. Gush, President of the Graduating Class asking for a 2 weeks leave vacation - On mot. that they be allowed 1 week, the instructors to reserve the right ^{to keep three in class} if the work is not satisfactory. From Miss Alexis to drop History of Painting - On mot. granted.

Moved that 5 hours in Preparatory be reduced to 4 hours per course - Amended that all Prep courses be on 4 point basis - except Gymnasium & Draw. Carried.

M. that Trig. be scheduled 4 hours per week for first semester. - led.

M. that the limit of hours without petition be made 18 instead of 16.

Amended that students be allowed to take 18 hours without petition, if they have had no conditions at in the preceding semester or are behind in their work

Moved to adjourn - Dec. - Carried.
