The Constitution was read article by article moved, 2^d Carried - Ref to Article II Sect I. [Treasurer be added. - who shall be a member of the faculty.]

Article II, Sect II last clause be read to read: - Both President and vice President must have attended the University as college students at least two years previous to their election, ^{and have at least 6+ credits.}
