#### DISCUSSION:

Chairman Sterling Rygg called the twelfth meeting of the Revenue and Finance Committee to order at 10:32 a.m., Monday, February 1, in Room 215, Mitchell Building.

Mr. Rygg assigned Mr. McDonough the task of researching and making recommendations on the two Ordinances assigned to the cornittee.

After Mr. Rygg read the agenda for the day, the committee began their consideration of the articles assigned to them, and spent the remainder of the morning discussing those articles. The committee recessed at noon.
