### GREAT FALLS-AREA UM STUDENTS STUDY ABROAD

#### MISSOULA--

Three University of Montana-Missoula students from the Great Falls area will study overseas through international exchange programs during the 1995-96 academic year.

Communication studies major Darrell Lasneski of Great Falls will spend fall semester in Sweden as an International Student Exchange Program participant.

Direct exchanges with international universities will send Choteau students Travis Sherman and Tanya Richem abroad for a year. Sherman, a prelaw and Japanese major, will study at Kumamoto University in Japan, while Richem, an English and education major, will begin a year of study at Massey University in New Zealand beginning spring semester 1996.

Eighteen UM students will attend universities in nine countries as part of international exchange programs this academic year.
