## REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON DEFECTIVE ENGLISH.

I. The Purpose of The Committee:- To devise a definite and practicable means of securing a correct written and spoken English on the part of college students conspicuously deficient therein.

II. The Committee recommends the following measures:-

1. That a special class in English Composition be arranged for these students, designed to correct just such <sup>deficiencies</sup> ~~differences~~. (In the judgment of the committee a "special class" seems necessary because (1) no college English, as such, can serve the purpose, and (2) no credit toward a degree should be given for work of such an elementary character).

2. That all students of the University notably deficient in English be required to take this course.

3. That no credits be given for the work; but also, that no student be given a degree who does not complete this work to the satisfaction of the instructor in charge.

4. That the method of determining the membership of this class be as follows:

(Either "a" or "b").

(a). An examination in English shall be given to all students upon their registration, and those failing to reach the required standard shall be obliged to enter this class.

(b) All students found deficient in English, shall be recommended by their instructors to take this course. This deficiency shall be determined by their work in all subjects, and the recommendation shall be made as soon as possible (e.g. by
