Faculty met upon call by Pres Craig to discuss the report of Com on Defective English.

Class rolls were called for by the President - to be handed in by Friday Feb 7<sup>th</sup> P.M.

The Report of the Com on Defective English was read moved by Prof Elrod:

(1) That the Faculty approve of that part of the report of the Committee on Defective English recommending that a special class be formed. That the faculty recommends that such a class be organized, to meet twice per week, provided that the President can make such an adjustment of Classes as will make the plan feasible.

(2) That the Committee be continued, raised in number to five, and be requested to work out a definite plan for operation in Sept. 1908.

Moved 2<sup>d</sup> Carried that clause 1 be accepted.

President appointed the following <sup>additional 2.</sup> members of the Committee.

Prof. Corbie Elrod.

Moved that the different members of the faculty canvass the class rolls, and report to the instructor those, who in their judgment should go into the class, - and to report not later than Friday. 2<sup>d</sup> Carried.

Amended - to read 'College Classes' - 2<sup>d</sup> Carried.
