Feb. 11. Th. 4 P.M.

Faculty met in regular session. The minutes of the ² previous meetings were read and approved. The following resolution presented at a former meeting was read:

That the funds that have accumulated from the Inter-scholastic Athletic meet and from the Interscholastic debate be placed in a fund, to be known as the "Students Aid Fund," to be loaned to needy students and that a Committee be appointed to devise a plan and recommend to the faculty some method of operation.

Moved to delay action until after track-meet.

That the faculty authorize the transfer of the sum of \$493.00 from the Interscholastic fund to the A.S.U.M. to liquidate the note made by the officers of the A.S.U.M. - 2^d Carried. The following resolution was presented:

That inasmuch as the control of student activities in the University of Montana has been placed under the control of the A.S.U.M. and the faculty, [that we disapprove of collections being taken or subscriptions solicited by members of the University for any purpose without the approval of the President and Faculty of the University]

Moved that the resolution be adopted - 2^d Carried.

February 18th 4 P.M.

Faculty met in regular session. The minutes were read and app'd.

The Com. having charge of Miss M. Tuttle's petition reported her registration approved.

The Committee in charge of Miss Vereen Black's registration reported her registration as having been approved.

Mr. Ed. Wenger, secretary of the A.S.U.M. - communicated with the Faculty regarding the Bond Instruments & moneys collected by Mr. E. C. Howard.

Moved that the secretary write to Mr. E. C. Howard to give an account of moneys collected & also list of persons holding Bond instruments. - Carried.
