8   Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) is bound by its Fiscal  
9   Policy;

10  
11   Whereas, Section 20.6 of ASUM Fiscal Policy currently reads:

12                   *20.6 General operating budgets for student groups that did not participate in the*  
13                   *budgeting process the prior year shall be funded through S.T.I.P. interest.*  
14

15   Whereas, this is no longer how ASUM funds new student groups that did not participate in  
16   budgeting the previous year;

17  
18   Whereas, Special Allocation is the preferred and more usual method for funding these  
19   uncommon student groups;

20  
21   Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that Section 11.0 “Special Allocation” of ASUM Fiscal Policy be  
22   amended to include a new subsection (11.6):

23                   *11.6 General operating budgets for student groups that did not participate in the budgeting*  
24                   *process the prior year shall be funded through the Special Allocation Account or STIP per the*  
25                   *designation of Fiscal Policy.*

27   Therefore, Let It Further Be Resolved, that Section 20.6 of ASUM Fiscal Policy be amended to  
28   read as follows:

29                   *20.6 S.T.I.P. requests must have a value of at least \$150. Items that do not individually*  
30                   *exceed \$150 may be grouped together until \$150 is reached.*

32   Therefore, Let It Further Be Resolved, that Section 20.10 of ASUM Fiscal Policy be eliminated,  
33   as its language has been included in a more appropriate section.
