1. The minutes of June 3, 1987 were approved as written.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2. Dr. Barbara Hollmann, Dean of Students, thanked the Board for their time, interest and energy serving as Central Board delegate in behalf of students. Hollmann encouraged members to stop in and visit her office in Main Hall.

7. Brooks reported that the Scholarship and Financial Aid Committee has handled several appeals over the last few months.


OLD BUSINESS




Dear Scott and Mike,
