September 12, 1910.

The first Faculty meeting of the academic year 1910-1911 was held on the call of the President at 11:00 A. M. Absent; Reynolds.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The President asked for corrections by the various members of the Faculty in the schedule of classes for the current semester.

Schedule

The President announced the arrangement of plans for a course of lectures in Elementary Law to be given two times a week, open to all students, during the first semester, and proposed that one hour's credit be given for this work. Moved by Harkins and seconded by Rowe that the Faculty approve this new course as proposed by the President. The motion was unanimously adopted.

Courses

~~XXX~~ General directions and suggestions concerning registration and enrollment of students for the next day were then discussed.

It was suggested by the President that a regular time for Faculty meetings might be set.

Departments employing student assistants were asked by the President to hand in necessary requests and specific recommendations for appointment of assistants at as early a date as possible.

Invitations

The President presented to the Faculty invitations from the University of North Dakota, Smith College and Philomath College to be represented at the inauguration of Presidents.

Moved by Rowe and seconded by Book that the President be authorized to write appropriate responses. The motion was unanimously adopted.

The report of the committee appointed at the meeting of the Faculty on June 3, 1910, concerning scholarship was presented by the chairman, Professor Book. Moved by Aber and seconded by Elrod to adopt the report. After an informal discussion, it was moved by Rowe and seconded by Richter to lay the report on the table until the next meeting of the Faculty. The motion to lay on the table was unanimously adopted.

On motion of Elrod, seconded by Rowe, the faculty adjourned to meet on the following Thursday at 4:10 P. M.
