Voice Area Master Classes

Course Objective: to meet with the entire voice area and work in a master class situation. Co-requisite with applied study.

Course Activities: Voice faculty may address a specific aspect of singing, or 4-6 students may sing a piece and be worked with by the faculty.

Grading: Grades will be based on attendance and participation. Students must sing in class 3-5 times, depending on their year. Professor will specify.
