February 24, 1911

A special meeting of the Faculty was held at 4:10 P. M. Absent: R. H. Cary, Elrod, Rowe, Speer.

In the absence of the Secretary, Professor Scheuch was appointed secretary pro tem. The reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

The President suggested the appropriateness of a Faculty expression of thanks to Mrs. W. W. Dixon of Washington, D. C. for he Mrs. gift of \$5,000 and her late husband's Law Library for the new Law Diyon Department. Professor Aber submitted the following letter which was unanimously adopted:

"The Faculty of the University of Montana desires to thank you for the generous and timely gifts, which did so much toward seuring the establishment of the Law Department.

"The names of yourself and your distinguished husband will ever be held in honored remembrance by the University as benefactors."
