The President brought up the matter of student attendance at classes, and a short discussion of rules on the subject ensued.


Professor Book presented revised rules for the University certificate of Qualifications to Teach. After discussion it was moved by Elrod and seconded by Harkins to defer action to the next meeting of the Faculty, which motion was unanimously adopted.

Professor Elrod, chairman of the committee on Student Affairs, reported that the management of the Glee Club had withdrawn their petition for a spring tour.

The President discussed briefly the proposed Summer School and the status of University appropriations.

Professor Scheuch asked the approval of the Faculty for a new student organization to be known as the German Club. Moved by Plant and seconded by Book that the request be granted. The motion was unanimously adopted.


March 29, 1911.

A special meeting of the Faculty was held on the call of the President at 4:10 P. M. Absent: R. H. Cary and Rowe.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The President read a communication from the State Board of Examiners to the effect that the following legislative appropriations were "suspended" and not available for use at the present time: For Engineering building, \$50,000; for Additional Land, \$40,000; for Summer School, \$10,000; for Biological Station building (part), \$3,000.

After informal discussion of these matters the meeting adjourned.
