RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the University of Montana will adopt a semester system in the fall of 1992; and,
- WHEREAS, the date established as the beginning of the school term is critical to student concerns; and,
- WHEREAS, many student jobs in Montana are dependent on industries like tourism, forestry, and agriculture, whose seasons end only after Labor Day; and,
- WHEREAS, the monumental change from the current quarter system to a semester system should be buffered with as little a change as possible in starting dates; and,
- WHEREAS, a later starting date would mean less time spent on campus and reduced room and board costs for students; and,
- WHEREAS, starting after Labor Day requires fifty-five or sixty minute class periods; and,
- WHEREAS, a period of at least two days is necessary between the last day of instruction and final examinations,
- THEREFORE, be it resolved that the ASUM Senate favors and recommends two four-month semesters with fifty-five minute periods followed by a special semester and an academic calendar starting date after Labor Day with orientations prior to the starting date.
