ASUM SENATE MINUTES
Cascade Dining Room
November 9, 1988
6:00 p.m.

Chairwoman Hiett called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. Senators present were Aylsworth, Chaffin, Fisher, Hagerman, Hollenbaugh, Nelson, Page, Peterson, Pettinato, Prezeau, Redick, Rohweder, Schustrom, Williams, Stoianoff (6:30), Wiltse, Yockey, Warden, Isern, and Hurlbut. Senators Cate and Long were unexcused. Senator Wimmer was excused.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. The minutes of November 2, 1988 were approved as written.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2. Isern introduced Pat Edgar, Senate Advisor. Edgar stated that the Senators were representations of the student body. It is the Senators' job to bring other student's opinions to the meetings--representation is a responsibility. Edgar encouraged lively debate as long as the debate pertains to the matter at hand. Edgar also encouraged the Senators to stop in at LA 415 and give opinions and comments.
3. Isern introduced Bobbie Hoe, Student Action Center Director. Hoe gave a brief history of the SAC office. Hoe explained that the Student Action Center broke from MONTPIRG several years ago. Hoe stated that SAC now deals with environmental issues, apartheid, peace, local and national issues. Hoe explained that a great deal of information is in her office addressing a broad range of topics. Hoe, next, outlined her plans for fundraising and issues for this year.
4. Isern - Page motioned to accept Steven Young to the Board on Budget and Finance. Upon vote, motion passed.
5. Isern - Chaffin motioned to suspend Bylaws to vote on the Isern motion to create an ex-officio position for the Dorm Council chair. Upon vote, motion passed.

Hurlbut - Isern motioned to accept the ex-officio position of Dorm Council Chair to the Senate and to accept Ward Thomas to that position. Upon vote, motion passed.
6. Isern reported that the Montana Associated Students Conference went very well. Isern thanked the Senators for attending.
7. Isern encouraged the Senators to read the News and Publications memo regarding Ivy League status for UM.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

8. Hiatt passed around the ASUM retreat sign-up sheet.
9. Hiatt announced committee appointments.

Page - Rohweder motioned to accept Sara Fenter, Greg Van Horssen and Dean Steusland to the Student Complaint Committee. Upon vote, motion passed.

Page - Nelson motioned to accept Sara Fenter to the Controller's Search Committee. Upon vote, motion passed.

Wiltse - Schustrom motioned to accept Handi Kenjono and Tana Doyle to the International Student Committee. Upon vote, motion passed.

10. Hiatt introduced Sue Vining, Food Service Director. Vining gave a brief history of the Cascade Dining Room. Vining then gave the Senators a tour of the dining facilities in the Lodge.

BUSINESS MANAGER'S REPORT

11. Hurlbut reported that the Fiscal Policy is finally completed. Hurlbut requested that the Senators take their old Fiscal Policy to the retreat to compare with the new one.
12. Hurlbut introduced Kyle Fickler, the 1987-88 Business Manager. Fickler explained the circumstances surrounding the 1988-89 budgeting session for the Kyi-Yo Indian Club. Fickler then fielded questions from the Senators.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

13. Stoianoff reported that the University Athletics Committee is considering dropping the indoor track program. The bylaws, however, state a minimum of six sports is required. A golf team is under consideration for reinstatement.

14. Isern - Hurlbut motioned to suspend the bylaws and vote on the Resolution for Consolation for the MSU Bobcats. Upon vote, motion passed.

Isern - Hurlbut motioned to accept the Resolution of Consolation. Discussion followed. Upon vote, motion passed.

15. Hurlbut - Page motioned to accept the Fiscal Policy.
