A 1994 graduate of Havre High School completed an internship administered by The University of Montana Center for Work-Based Learning. Kelsen Young, a UM senior majoring in social work, was an advocate intern for YWCA Pathways of Missoula.

As part of her internship, Young helped women who experience domestic violence. She also answered calls to a crisis line, worked at a shelter and assisted survivors of sexual assault.
