8 Whereas, section 4.4 subsection 4.41 of the ASUM Personnel Policy currently reads as follows:

9 *Director (1 classified position, 1.FTE 12 mo.): Primary responsibility of directing 4*
10 *child care/preschool centers, the Drop-In Care at Campus Recreation and Health*
11 *Facility, Griz Kidz Care for UM home basketball games, the Babysitting Exchange and*
12 *the Family Referral and Resource Program. Director also administers the USDA Child*
13 *and Adult Food Program operations within the child care preschool centers. The child*
14 *Care Preschool has supervision responsibilities over all classified employees of the Child*
15 *Care Preschool Program. Director must receive 30 hours of training annually and*
16 *conduct staff meetings and staff training. Director must be an approved Professional*
17 *Development Specialist II or III.*

19 Whereas, section 4.4 subsection 4.44 of the ASUM Personnel Policy currently reads as follows:

20 *Center Assistant Teachers (4 classified positions, 4=1. FTE 12 mo.): Primary*
21 *responsibility is the supervision of the children enrolled, and assisting the lead teacher in*
22 *the childcare preschool program daily routine. Assistant teachers must receive 24 hours*
23 *of training annually, and participate in staff meetings as requested.*

25 Whereas, section 4.4 subsection 4.45 of the ASUM Personnel Policy currently reads as follows:

26 *Student Teacher Aides (approximately 65 student positions each semester): Primary*
27 *responsibility is to assist the teachers with supervision of the children, preparation of*
28 *meals and snacks as instructed, prepare educational materials as directed, and assist*
29 *with housekeeping duties as required. Student teacher aides are also required to*
30 *participate in 8 hours of training annually and attend staff meetings as requested.*

31 Whereas, these descriptions are not up-to-date and do not accurately demonstrate how ASUM
32 Childcare is operating due to the disappearance of certain programs and the modification of
33 licensing requirements;

36 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, that section 4.4 subsection 4.41 of the ASUM Personnel Policy be
37 updated to read as follows:

38 *Director (1 classified position, 1.FTE 12 mo.): Primary responsibility of directing 4*
39 *childcare/preschool centers, ~~the Drop-In Care at Campus Recreation and Health~~*
40 *Facility, ~~Griz Kidz Care for UM home basketball games~~, the Babysitting Exchange and*
41 *the Family Referral and Resource Program. Director also administers the USDA Child*

43 *Care Preschool has supervision responsibilities over all classified employees of the Child*

44 *Care Preschool Program. Director must receive 30 hours of training annually and*
45 *conduct staff meetings and staff training. Director must be an approved Professional*
46 *Development Specialist II or III.*

47 Therefore, Let It Further Be Resolved, that section 4.4 subsection 4.44 of the ASUM Personnel
48 Policy be updated to read as follows:

49 *Center Assistant Teachers (6 classified positions, 4=1. FTE 12 mo.): Primary*
50 *responsibility is the supervision of the children enrolled, and assisting the lead teacher in*
51 *the childcare preschool program daily routine. Assistant teachers must receive 24 hours*
52 *of training annually, and participate in staff meetings as requested.*

54 Therefore, Let It Further Be Resolved, that section 4.4 subsection 4.45 of the ASUM Personnel
55 Policy be updated to read as follows:

56 *Student Teacher Aides (approximately 65 student positions each semester): Primary*
57 *responsibility is to assist the teachers with supervision of the children, preparation of*
58 *meals and snacks as instructed, prepare educational materials as directed, and assist*
59 *with housekeeping duties as required. Student teacher aides are also required to*
60 *participate in 16 hours of training annually and attend staff meetings as requested.*
61 *Student teacher aides must also be First Aid certified and Infant, Child, & Adult CPR*
62 *certified within 30 days of hire (paid for independently of ASUM Childcare).*
