Faust, Hilda; to substitute for 2 hours physical culture recommended to Faculty by committee on Admission and Registration; petition granted.

Heyward, Gladys L., to substitute for 2 hours physical culture, recommended to Faculty by committee on Admission and Registration; petition granted.

Hutchinson, Anne E., to substitute for 2 hours physical culture, recommended to Faculty by committee on Admission and Registration; petition granted.

Kramer, Cecil., to substitute for 1 hour physical culture recommended to Faculty by committee on Admission and Registration; petition granted.

President E. B. Craighead requested that all recommendations for student assistants be reported without further delay.

Petition of the Class of 1915, presented to President E. B. Craighead was referred to the Faculty; the Class of 1915 petitioned the President and Faculty of the University of Montana requesting the privilege of plotting, planting and caring for the small triangular piece of ground just inside the main gate of the campus, for the purpose of decoration in a manner appropriate to the campus of our University. On motion duly seconded and unanimously carried the petition was referred to President Craighead with power to take such action as was deemed best.

The relation of the Faculty, or a Faculty committee to the A. S. U. M., in a business and financial way was discussed. On motion unanimously carried the question was referred to President E. B. Craighead with power to act.

Prof. Reynolds presented the following resolution: "That new students, except special students, shall be required to take English 1 and 11 in their first year, unless they are excused by the Department of English on the presentation of certificates of equivalent courses elsewhere by the committee on Admission and Registration on petition.
