**WHITEFISH STUDENT AWARDED ERASMUS SCHOLARSHIP**

**MISSOULA--**

Brendan Magone, a senior studying English and drama at The University of Montana-Missoula, was recently awarded an Erasmus Scholarship for the 1998-99 academic year. Thirty-seven scholarships worth between \$500 and \$1,930 were given. The Department of Philosophy administered the scholarships.

A 1990 graduate of Whitefish High School, Magone is the son of Laurence and Barbara Magone of **Whitefish**.

Erasmus scholarships are granted on the basis of need to students who demonstrate the ability and intention to work toward farsighted, humanistic ideals. Erasmus scholarships provide awards to full-time graduate and undergraduate students who have declared a major in English, the environmental studies master's program, foreign languages and literatures, history, law, philosophy, political science or an interdisciplinary studies master's program.
