FACULTY MEETING, JANUARY 29, 1914, 4:30 P. M., Room 4.

Meeting called to order by President E. B. Craighead.

Absent: Professors Ayer, Bolton, Bonner, Elrod, Macleod,

Mustaine, Staehling, Trexler and Whitlock.

President Craighead announced the meetings of the Montana Horticultural Society and urged Faculty and students to attend. Notices were posted in all University buildings calling attention to Horticultural Society Meetings.

President Craighead announced Commercial Club Luncheon at Palace Hotel at Noon July 30, 1914.

The following communication from the Committee on Student Affairs was read:

"The Committee on Student Affairs recommends to
the Faculty that the new dances such as the Tango,
Grape Vine, etc., be forbidden at all University functions

On motion duly seconded, the recommendation was unanimously adopted.

The Committee on Student Affairs presented the following:

"The Alumni of the University of Montana ask to reserve the evening of Charter Day, February 20th, for a dance to be given in University Gymnasium.

The Committee on Student Affairs recommends that this petition be granted.

On motion duly seconded the request was unanimously adopte
Report on schedule of courses for prospective teachers
was asked for. The matter was deferred to next meeting.

Professor Mollett (Pharmacy) presented schedule of courses in Pharmacy. On motion duly seconded and carried, schedule adopted.

Professor Aber called to the attention of the Faculty that February 3, 1914, was official registration day for second semester. It was suggested that the matter be presented to the Faculty on Monday, February 2, 1914, at 3 P.M.

Tentative Basket Ball schedule was presented. Recommended that Athletic Committee arrange Basket Ball Schedule.

Professor Kirkwood suggested change in Correspondence Study in Botany and Forestry.

Motion by Professor Rowe, seconded and unanimously carried that "Departments be allowed to make necessary changes in Courses of Study without bringing the matter before the Faculty."

On motion meeting adjourned to meet Monday, February 2, 1914, at 3 P. M.
