Resolved, that the Faculty interpret the rules on eligibility for extra-curricular activity to mean that it is the duty of any member of the Faculty having such activity in charge on their own initiative to present to the scholarship committee a list of names of all students who desire to participate in such activity, together with the necessary credential and that it is the duty of the scholarship committee to certify to the eligibility or ineligibility of the students named in such lists.

Meeting called to order by President Craighead.

Roll Call.

Absent: Skeels Swenson.

Eligibility Rules under discussion.

Motion by Professor Lennes, "that all eligibility rules be suspended". Motion lost.

Motion by Professor Rowe, Seconded, "that the men in question be allowed until tomorrow noon to make up their work".

After discussions, questions called for. On a standing vote 13 voted in the affirmative, 14 negative.

After further discussion, Professor Ayer moved that the former motions be reconsidered. Motion lost.

Professor Bonner, Motion "that all Faculty rules be suspended this occasion". Motion lost.

Professor Kemp: "I move as a substitute that the rules be waved the time being in reference to Guerin." Motion not voted on.

Motion by Professor Lennes "that the Scholarship Committee wire Hazeman, asking specific questions about these men and have another Faculty meeting". Motion not voted upon.

Professor Stone asked a question with reference to credits for editorship of the Kaimin under the rules for extra curricular activities.

Professor Rowe: "I move to strike out 'editorship of the Kaimin'" Motion carried.
