FACULTY MEETING, Monday, September 13, 1915.

11:30 A.M. Room No. 4.

Meeting called to order by President Scheuch.

Roll called. Absent: Belle Bateman, Burleigh, Knowles, Phillips, Skeels, and Whitlock.

Minutes of previous meeting read and ordered approved.

President Scheuch announced that the Faculty meeting had been called to consider the Schedule for 1915-1916.

Proof copies of Schedule were distributed, and Faculty members were requested to note changes and notify Prof. Carey of the Schedule Committee.

Details concerning registration were explained by Prof. Rowe.

The Committee on ~~Admission and Registration~~ ^{Graduate Work} reported that Sylvia Brady had completed the required work, and recommended that the applicant be granted the degree of M.A., major subject English; and William Tow, having completed the required work be granted the degree of M.A., major subject Economics. Unanimously adopted.

The Committee on Admission and Registration recommended that Sylvia Brady and William Tow be granted Certificate of Qualification to Teach. Recommendation unanimously adopted.
