FACULTY MEETING, October 14, 1915.4 P.M. , Room 4.

Meeting called to order by Acting President F. C. Scheuch.

Dr. R. H. Jesse, Jr., of the Committee on Graduate Work, recommended that Mr. Albert Keiser, having completed the required amount of work be granted the degree of M.A. <sup>Major Subject English</sup> Unanimously approved. ✓

Petition of Kathryn Sutherlin approved by Prof. Geo. R. Coffman, and recommended by the Committee on Admission and Registration that petitioners be allowed to substitute two courses (Sociology) four hours for the required courses, six hours, in "History and Economics", the petitioner not working for Teacher's Certificate, and parents want her to take Textiles". Granted.

President F. C. Scheuch presented the matter of stated time for Faculty Meetings. After discussion, the consensus of opinion favored Faculty meetings called by the President.
