## FACULTY MEETING.

May 18, 1916 - Room No. 4.

4:15 P.M.

Meeting called to order by Acting President E. C. Scheuch.

Minutes Faculty Meeting, February 16, 1916, read and approved. Faculty resolution of April 11, 1916, adopted. Faculty minutes May 9, 1916, read.

By Prof. Coffman: I wish to offer recommendation to give two college credits to a student taking part in intercollegiate debate. I recommend that any student who has taken or is taking the first course in debate here at the University or has had its equivalent elsewhere be given two college credits a year for taking part in intercollegiate debate. It is understood that the instructor of debating shall have final word as to the intercollegiate debate schedule.

Motion seconded and carried that the recommendation be adopted.


Prof. Coffman withdraws last paragraph of recommendation.

Prof. Rowe: I move that the recommendation be referred to a committee of three. Motion seconded and carried.

Prof. Daughters: I move to reconsider the first motion concerning this recommendation. Motion seconded and carried.

Chancellor Edward C. Elliott addressed the Faculty upon the budget and organization.
