15 Whereas, There is currently no language in ASUM bylaws regarding summer appointments;

17 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That the following language be added to Article IV Section 7 of
18 the ASUM bylaws:

19 *5. Any candidates who lose the ASUM election must not be interviewed or appointed until*
20 *the beginning of the following Fall semester. Applications may be submitted throughout*
21 *the summer but will not be reviewed until the fall semester begins, interviews will take*
22 *place within the first weeks of fall semester.;*
