8   Whereas, The University of Montana (UM) has historically been in the national spotlight for  
9   mishandling sexual assault cases on campus;

10  
11   Whereas, UM is continuously seeking ways to improve the campus environment to be more safe  
12   and accessible;

13  
14   Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) represents all students  
15   and aims to create a more inclusive and safe environment;

16  
17   Whereas, UM has impactful services that focus on specific aspects of sexual assault but do not  
18   have the resources to address all needs in regards to the issue;

19  
20   Whereas, “One in five women and one in 71 men will be raped at some point in their lives”<sup>1</sup>;

21  
22   Whereas, “1 in 4 women and 1 in 9 men experience severe intimate partner physical violence,  
23   intimate partner contact sexual violence, and/or intimate partner stalking with impacts such as  
24   injury, fearfulness, post-traumatic stress disorder, use of victim services, contraction of sexually  
25   transmitted diseases, etc”<sup>2</sup>;

27   Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That ASUM establish the J. Doe Ad Hoc Committee;

29   Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That the charge of the ASUM J. Doe Ad Hoc Committee read:

31                               *In order to create a comprehensive report on financial needs for survivors, assess the needs of*  
32                               *survivors that are not being met, and establish a marketing campaign for the University and its*  
33                               *students surrounding sexual assault and domestic violence;*


