MONTANA NATURAL HISTORY CENTER READY TO UNVEIL MURAL, PRINT

MISSOULA--

A new watercolor mural by renowned Missoula artist Kendahl Jan Jubb will be unveiled at a wine and cheese reception hosted by the Montana Natural History Center, which commissioned the painting.

The mural, a three-panel triptych, will pay homage to the landscape and creatures that surround the center's new home at Fort Missoula. Jubb is known for her bold, colorful watercolors of flora and fauna, which can be seen locally at Sutton West Gallery and at the Old Town Cafe.

A print of one of the panels also will be introduced at the reception.
