Whereas, Current Website Upkeep Committee bylaws under Article IV, Section 26, Subsection A in the second to last sentence read :

The ASUM Website Upkeep Committee shall meet a minimum of twice per semester to recommend changes to the ASUM Web Developer.

Whereas, Current Website Upkeep Committee bylaws under Article IV, Section 26, Subsection D read :

Duties and Functions of the ASUM Website Upkeep Committee shall include: 1. The oversight and maintenance of the ASUM Website by an ASUM Web Developer.

Whereas, The ASUM Web Developer is a position that ASUM has only hired a number of times in the past and has since had the duties of the position fall onto either other members of ASUM or outsourced to a third party;

Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That the second to last sentence in Article IV, Section 26, Subsection A be amended to read:


The ASUM Website Upkeep Committee shall meet a minimum of twice per semester to workshop changes to be carried out by Website Upkeep Committee members, other ASUM team members with consent from the Website Upkeep Committee Chair, or a third party enlisted by Website Upkeep Committee;

Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That Article IV, Section 26, Subsection D be amended to read:


Duties and Functions of the ASUM Website Upkeep Committee shall include: 1. The oversight and maintenance of the ASUM Website.
