7   Whereas, The Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM) is bound by its Fiscal  
8   Policy;

10   Whereas, Section 14.1.1 of Fiscal Policy currently reads:

11         *14.1.1 At the beginning of each fiscal year, \$20,000 shall be deposited in the Travel*  
12         *Allocation Account. The Board on Budget and Finance shall not allocate more than 50%*  
13         *of this money during Fall semester, with the remaining 50% to be allocated during*  
14         *Spring semester.;*

16   Whereas, The need for the Travel Allocation minimum deposits to be increased has become  
17   apparent in recent years;

18  
19   Whereas, The Senate voted to add \$10,000 to the Travel Allocation account in FY '20 to  
20   accommodate for an increased strain on this account;

21  
22   Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That Section 14.1.1 of Fiscal Policy be amended to read:

23         *14.1.1 At the beginning of each fiscal year, \$26,000 shall be deposited in the Travel*  
24         *Allocation Account. The Board on Budget and Finance shall not allocate more than 50%*  
25         *of this money during Fall semester, with the remaining 50% to be allocated during*  
26         *Spring semester.;*

28   Therefore, Let It Be Further Resolved, That this resolution be sent to Marlene Hendrickson,  
29   ASUM Accountant; Gwen Coon, ASUM Office Manager; and Kenzie Carter, Student Group  
30   Resource Coordinator.
