8 Whereas, The University of Montana (UM) has subsidiary campuses, one of which is Bitterroot
9 College located in Hamilton, Montana;

11 Whereas, Bitterroot College students are currently assessed the same fees as students attending
12 the University of Montana Mountain Campus, Missoula College River Campus, and Missoula
13 College West Campus;

15 Whereas, Bitterroot College is 48 miles away from Missoula, outside of Missoula County;

17 Whereas, Some services that these students pay for are inaccessible to Bitterroot College
18 students;

20 Whereas, These students have difficulty utilizing the services that the ASUM Office of
21 Transportation or the Curry Health Center provides;

23 Whereas, ASUM believes that all students should be able to access the resources that students
24 pay for;

26 Therefore, Let It Be Resolved, That ASUM urges the administration to reassess and reduce or
27 eliminate the transportation and health service fee for students at Bitterroot College;

30 President of Operations and Finance; Victoria Clark, Bitterroot College Director; Jordan Hess,
