The Committee on Admission and Registration, Mr. Phillips, Chairman, recommended that he be allowed to substitute other credits for the remaining 14 credits in Foreign Languages required for the B. A. degree on account of impediment of speech; the petition was approved by Professors Scheuch and Coon. A motion to adopt the recommendation of the committee was unanimously approved.
- 4. Re: Sullivan. Stephen P. Recommendation from the Committee on Admission and Registration, Mr. Phillips, Chairman that he be allowed to fulfill the Foreign Language requirement for the B. A. degree by 14 hours of Spanish and 5 hours of French. A motion by Merrill to adopt the recommendation was approved.
