30 3.2 The ASUM Student Political Action Director will be paid at **18** hours per *every two weeks*
31 during a non-legislative year and at **28** hours per *every two weeks* during a legislative year. The
32 ASUM President may assign summer work with compensation as needed, not to exceed **18** hours

37 3.3 The Training wage for ASUM Transportation drivers shall be \$8.50. Upon completion of
38 training, the wage shall be \$9.50. Returning drivers will receive \$0.25/hour raise after each
39 semester of work. UDASH drivers will receive an additional half hour of pay while working the
40 late shift on weekends (10:30 p.m. to 3:00 a.m.). Student Lead Driver will receive a \$1.00/hour
41 raise when promoted to Lead Driver.
