Petitions (Individuals) 5. Petitions from the following students were presented by the Committee on Admission and Registration, Phillips, Chairman:

Van Zandt, Lynn: to be exempt from all requirements of foreign language.

Recommended by Committee. Petition granted by faculty.

Mather, Lloyd G.: to satisfy the requirement of foreign language by two entrance units of Latin.

Recommended by Committee. Petition denied. Motion by Shallenberger to re-consider was carried by vote of 29 to 11; motion to approve petition passed with vote of 27 to 12.

Centralized Exams 6. A recommendation from the Curriculum Committee was presented by Jesse that the faculty adopt a system of centralized proctoring of examinations, except departments conducting examinations under the honor system (at the present time the Law School), to be administered by the Schedule Committee. The recommendation was adopted by the faculty.

7. A recommendation from the Curriculum Committee that the rules concerning credit for membership in the band be not changed was approved by the faculty.

8. There being no further business before the faculty the meeting adjourned.
